

General care and maintenance of your hardwood floors:

- 1.** Light foot traffic after 6 ~ 24 hrs (socks only)
- 2.** Curing process takes approx. 7 days (70% cured after 1 day, 90% cured after 3 days. Curing is based on the use of Bona urethane)
- 3.** Do not place area rugs until floor has fully cured (7 -10 days)
- 4.** Furniture may be placed back after 72 hrs (Pick and set furniture, Do not slide furniture)
- 5.** Use felt tip pads under furniture legs, appliances, ETC
- 6.** Recommended floor cleaner. Available at most home stores:
Bona hardwood floor cleaner (Follow manufacturer's instructions for use)
- 7.** Vacuum or sweep floor regularly
- 8.** Avoid walking on wood floors in high heels. They can severely damage wood floors. Keep heels in good repair
- 9.** Keep pets claws properly trimmed to avoid excessive scratches and gouges
- 10.** Do not use wax, oil soap or other household cleaners on polyurethane finished wood floors. The use of these products can dull today's floor finishes and make refinishing or recoating difficult
- 11.** In 3-5 years consider having your floors screened and recoated (Call to learn more about the process).
